

Phonics Games for EYFS

- Splat – write the phonic sounds or words on to bits of paper, spread them out and call one out for your child to find and splat.
- Playing ‘I spy’ using sounds rather than letter names.
- Explore rhyming words – write a word at the top of a piece of paper, how many rhyming words can you think of for that word?
- Write sounds on the ground in chalk, children to use water pistols to wash away the sound that you call out.
- Sound hunt – pick a sound to focus on and walk around the house/garden finding words that include the chosen sound.
- Silly Soup – using the rhyme shown below, a saucepan and a spoon can you add rhyming words to the silly soup?
Alternatively, you can put in a sound and add words that include the chosen sound.
